Dear Mr. Bluejacket:

This is in response to your request for an extension to a previously approved exception to the mailing standards pertaining to privately printed PS Forms 3811, *Domestic Return Receipt*, and for approval of the redesigned PS Form 3811, *Domestic Mail Receipt* facsimile for future use by your client Blumberg and identified as CMF 088.

Effective May 31, 2015, a correct Intelligent Mail package barcode (IMpb) is required on items for which extra services are paid (*Domestic Mail Manual* 503.1.7.3).

If authorized, a mailer may use privately printed extra service forms and labels for domestic mail only, if the forms and labels are nearly identical in design elements and color to the USPS form, with an Intelligent Mail package barcode (IMpb) and human-readable numbers that meet USPS specifications in DMM 708.5.0 (DMM 503.1.7.2).

I approve your request for an extension to a previously approved exception to the mailing standards pertaining to the inclusion of an Intelligent Mail package barcode (IMpb) on PS Form 3811 *Domestic Return Receipt* for your PS Form 3811, printed without the required IMpb, until March 3, 2016.

Additionally, I approve your redesigned PS Form 3811, shown below, with an IMpb, provided that the IMpb has been certified by the National Customer Service Support Center, until March 3, 2016.

At this time I cannot approve your redesigned PS Form 3811, depicted above, beyond March 3, 2016, as explained below.

Since your privately printed PS Form 3811 depicted above is not nearly identical in design elements to the USPS form, we need time to identify any negative effects your design may have on postal operations and costs.


For this reason, at this time I cannot approve your redesigned PS Form 3811 beyond March 3, 2016. If you need to reorder stock, you must be careful not to order a quantity that you do not expect to exhaust before March 3, 2016.

This exception is for PS Form 3811, *Domestic Return Receipt*, identified as CMF 088 used by your client Blumberg, printed without an IMpb and for the design depicted above with an approved IMpb. This exception expires on March 3, 2016. You may apply for an extension if additional time is needed, however, approval is not guaranteed.

A copy of this letter must accompany each mailing your client presents that does not include an IMpb on PS Form 3811.
